 - \$2,000 plus cost of poster?
 - Possible to donate \$2,000 and then \$1,000 more if needed
 - Maybe we should get a budget from them?
 - Give \$2,000 and stipulate a budget to receive the \$1,000 more
 - Poster- should we pay for it? Probably

- Computers
 - We were paying 2 costs in budget
 - Computers = \$33,000
 - Programs
 - We need to figure out what costs how much before we can vote!

 - High quality fit-outs of interiors
 - 3rd year fall studio, 351/341
 - Creating a lasting design legacy for the school
 - Would help create a student lounge at f-stop
 - Requestion mone for raw materials only
 - Prefabricated architectural inserts, with the help of fabrication technology
 - A collaborative studio with one shared project
 - Would shift how the design tools (like the router) are used and help create a new school culture
 - Lots of schools are doing this
 - With our tools, we can make these projects high quality in a short amount of time
 - Are we interested in supporting this class?
 - Budget set at \$5,000
 - How do we decide who gets in?
 - Not sure yet...
 - How do we get out info about this class?
 - Some people may worry that they are sacrificing architectural design if they took this class
 - This is a real design class!
 - If it were an elective, it would take too much time
 - May help limit the number of students who will sign up to take it
 - Is 18 students too many?
 - A circus sometimes, but manageable

- Working with a group is challenging but necessary
 - A real design problem- minimize cost and materials while maximizing design
 - Students need to be aware of what they would be signing up for first!
 - Fall is a great time to offer this class- it lets the information learned by these 18 students ripple out
 - Would help emphasize the tools we have
 - Everyone should be able to use them!
 - This studio would just allow more in-depth work
 - Help to see interiors as real projects and real buildings
 - How would purchasing materials work?
 - Can be expensive
 - Some could be donated (would be asking for donations)
 - What other materials besides wood do we use?
 - \$5,000 seems rather arbitrary
 - Is fall the only time it works to offer this class?
 - Yes- during practice
 - Right scale for a first quarter 3rd year project
- CRS
 - A swipe card system is not possible
 - A username/password system is however
 - Use to access plotter
 - Stickers
 - \$10 set up fee, \$1 per sticker
 - Go to another sticker company then?
 - How big should the stickers be?
 - 2" x 3" or so
 - other sizes for specific things maybe?
 - 11 x 17 printers
 - Going into room 308 SOON!
