- Mike Montoya joined meeting to discuss his class relating to LEED and the reimbursement of students taking, and passing, the LEED test.
 - The test costs \$400 to take.
 - There are currently about 10 students from Arch. dept. taking the class and therefore may possibly take the test.
 - Mr. Montoya currently teaches the class on his own time, but if picked up formally by the school, he could see as many as 150 architecture students per year taking the class and theoretically taking and passing the class.
 - We discussed paying for at least the 10 students this year with the option of discussing more if needed. This equals a cost of \$4000.
 - Also discussed was plan funding rollover options as well as overdraft options and partial payments.
- Vote on first aid kits – Approved unanimously
- Discussed Jon's research into a rapid prototype machine.
 - \$30,000 first time cost includes \$25k for machine and \$5k worth of consumable material.
 - The machine can produce 8"x8"x12" prints.
 - Students would have to pay for materials used to purchase more later, but the system for how to best do this is still being researched.
 - While the unit is self contained, it still needs to be in a controlled environment like the laser cutter. Because of this, they would most likely want to be in the same room.
