You may have already entered your profile information under the old Resume Center using meta-tags. The tags have been retired in favor of a much easier to work with Job Interests page. To participate fully in the Resume Center moving forward, you will have to update this information on the "Your Account" > "Profile" > "Job Interests" page. This is all spelled out in the online help.

Once you have placed your resume in the system, all you have to do is wait for prospective employers to review your resume. To preserve your privacy, prospective employers can only contact you via the Be Communities' private message system (you'll receive notification to your email address that a message is waiting for you)—so visit often.
